

SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

- Remove the tent from bag in an open space, and carefully allow the greenhouse to pop open.
- Remove poles from the bag and assemble them into shape by fitting the loose ends together in a straight line.
- Set the poles to the side and invert the greenhouse into an upside-down position for easier assembly.
- 4. Locate the pole-mounting sleeves inside the greenhouse on the corner walls. The poles, when mounted correctly, will cross in arcs, creating a dome-like effect and allowing extra space for plants to grow inside the tent.
- Take one pole end and insert it into a corner mounting sleeve. We suggest using two hands to bend the pole with one hand and fit it into the mounting sleeve with the other hand
- 6. Once the first end is fitted into the sleeve, take the other pole end to the opposing corner of the greenhouse. With two hands, fit the other end of the pole into the opposing pole sleeve. Once both ends are in their opposing sleeves, double check both ends to make sure they are fitted securely.
- 7. Once one pole is secured, repeat the process with the 2nd pole using the available pole sleeves on the other corners. When the poles are secured properly, the poles should be crossing each other like an X, and clearly creating a dome-like effect on the greenhouse.
- 8. Use the strings to tie the poles in place for extra security, to keep them from shifting.
- Revert your greenhouse to an upright position, and you are ready to use your Pop-Greenhouse!
