SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE

Do not use a fungicide prior to application of this product. Do not apply this product through any type of irrigation system.

Application Instructions

Each bottle contains approximately 15 fl. oz. of balEnce, which treats 30,000 to 50,000 square feet of floor area. Apply balEnce at a rate of 1.5 to 2 fl. oz. per 5,000 square feet of floor area. Although balEnce can be applied with conventional equipment of the user's choice, there must not be any filter or screen smaller than 50 microns, which would prevent the active ingredient from passing. Be sure to agitate the contents of the bottle by shaking vigorously to re-suspend any sediment that formed in the bottom. Add the contents of the bottle to sufficient water in a mix tank to ensure even coverage over the treated area.
