Peach Tree Borer Trap & Lure

Moth Borer Facts

Clear-winged moths of the Borer family damage many types of trees when their larvae tunnel into roots and trunks. Moth Borers such as Peach Tree Borer, Dogwood Borer, Western and Eastern Lilac Borer, Rhododendron Borer, and other Borer moths can be monitored with this product.

Apply appropriate controls when moths are caught.

Easy to Install:

- 1 Attach hanger.
- 2 Grasp trap by top and bottom flaps and pull apart to form trap.
- 3 Open lure packet, and place one lure on the inside upper surface of the trap. (Do not touch the attractant lure.)
- 4 Hang the trap in the tree, 1 to 2 feet inside the tree canopy. Place traps in early spring, 1 to 2 weeks before bud break.

To Control Pests:


Moths may be captured at any time during the growing season.

Check traps every 2 to 3 days. If moths are caught, apply the appropriate treatment for control.

Recycle or dispose of traps after three months or when full of insects.








