## **DEAD-INN™ Stink Bug Trap Assembly Instructions**



Step 1:

Align slots on yellow triangle pieces to form pyramid.



Step 2:

Align 4 holes on yellow cone with tabs on pyramid and snap into place.



#### Step 3:

Open foil packet and remove both lures. Place both lures inside jar. Position does not matter.

(Do Not Puncture bubble on lures).



#### Step 4:

Snap jar onto
pyramid. Secure trap
outside at least 20ft away
from garden, fruit trees, or
infested area using supplied bungee cord

Best Time To Use Trap: Stink bugs coming out of hibernation are most interested in finding food (fruit, vegetables, flowers) since they have not fed all winter. Stink bugs only respond to the pheromone lure when they find food and their physiology changes from hibernation mode to a new feeding/ breeding mode. This does not happen when bugs first appear in the Spring/ early Summer, but takes a few weeks or longer. Recommended trap usage from June-September/October.\*

\*Stink bug response will vary in different parts of the country. Best results may not be seen until Mid-July.

**Placement of Trap:** Immature stink bugs do not fly, but only walk in their search for food. Adults both walk and fly. This is important in placement of the trap. To catch all stages of stink bugs the trap should be placed **outside** on the ground or other surface such as a deck or patio. Place at least 20 ft away from garden, fruit trees, and entrances to house. The lure will attract stink bugs away from these areas. Adults will fly to the trap in any location.

On ground: Secure base with stakes (included) thru holes in bottom of pyramid base piece which is NOT slotted on bottom.

On structures, such as deck or railing: Secure with bungee cord (included) thru holes in bottom of pyramid base piece which is NOT slotted on bottom.

**Stink bug disposal:** Unsecure trap from ground or structure. Turn over trap and unsnap jar from cone. Discard bugs in garbage or compost pile. If there are bugs still alive in trap, dump into bucket of soapy water or dump into plastic bag & tie shut.

**Included parts:** Pyramid base, cone, jar, 7 week lure, 2 metal stakes, 1 bungee cord.

**Warning:** Trap must be secured on structure or ground using the included stakes, elastic band or other tie-down method to prevent blow over.
