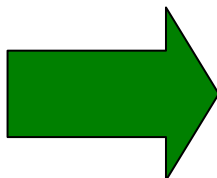


MYCOSTOP[®] BIOFUNGICIDE

For control of diseases caused by *Fusarium* sp., *Alternaria* sp., *Phytophthora* sp. and *Pythium* sp. (damping-off, wilt, root rot, stem and basal rot) in ornamentals, veg-etables and herbs. Also suppresses diseases caused by *Rhizoctonia* sp. and *Botrytis* sp.

SEEDLING PRODUCTION

Drench the growing media after seedling emergence.

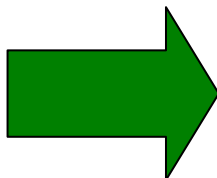


2-10 g/100 m²

Use **0.01%** suspension
20-100 litres/100 m²

GREENHOUSE CUCUMBER, TOMATO, PEPPER ETC.

Drench, spray or apply via drip irrigation immediately after transplanting. Repeat the treatment every 3-6 weeks.

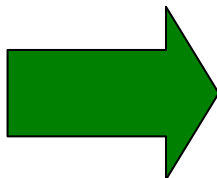


5-20 g/1000 plants
2-5 g/100 m²

Use **0.01%** suspension
50-200 litres/1000 plants
or 20-50 litres/100 m²

POT PLANTS AND CUT FLOWERS

Drench or spray pot plants immediately after potting. Treat the cut flowers by drench or spray immediately after planting. Repeat the treatment every 3-6 weeks.

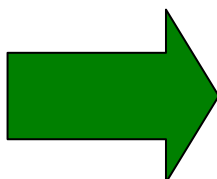


2-8 g/1000 plants
2-5 g/100 m²

Use **0.01%** suspension
20-80 litres/1000 plants
or 20-50 litres/100 m²

DRY SEED TREATMENT

Put the seeds and required amount of Mycostop powder in a container. Shake until the seeds are covered. Store the treated seeds in dry and cool and sow within a week.



0.5 g/100 g of seeds

Herbs, onions, leek and cabbage :
0.8 g/100 g of seeds

Lettuce, gerbera, sweet pepper:
0.4 g/100 g of seeds

Preparation of Mycostop suspension: Prepare the 0.01% suspension by diluting 1 g Mycostop powder in 10 litres of water. Prepare the 0.05% suspension by diluting 1 g of powder in 2 litres of water. First add the powder to approx. 0.5 litres of water. Let the suspension stand for 30 minutes. Agitate carefully and dilute in the final volume. Use the suspension on the same day of preparation.

Storage: Store in dry and cool below +8°C. In an unopened package Mycostop will remain active up to 12 months. Use the entire content of the package on the same day. If the packet is left open, Mycostop loses its activity.
