
WHERE TO USE

Place the trap near where animals will feed or water. Keep traps behind a fence so animals won't knock them down. They should be placed to get a lot of sunlight reflecting off them and with a contrasting background.

HOW DO THEY WORK

Face flies are attracted to the bright white surface when sunlight is reflected in a nearly horizontal plane. They get stuck on the replaceable stiky sleeve.






 Form the corrugated fiberglass into a cylinder (overlap the ends and align pre-punched holes.) Insert brass fasteners and bend ears flat.



 Hold the Stiky Sleeve[™] at one end and peel the release paper ½ way back on the sleeve



(length 5/16"



3) Fasten the Stiky Sleeve end to the cylinder with two giant paper clips. Wrap the sleeve around the rest of the cylinder while pulling off the rest of the release paper. Fasten the overlapped ends under the paper clips.

4) Step the stake (not provided with trap) into the ground at approximately a 50 to 60 degree angle with the horizon and so the open end of the cylinder points north.

When the Stiky Sleeve becomes covered with flies or debris, replace it.

Stiky Stuff may be removed from hands with waterless handcleaners or vegetable oil followed with soap and water.



PLACING THE TRAP

1) Direct sunlight is best.

2) Where animals congregate for watering or feeding.

 Position on the other side of fences or where animals will not trample it.

 Locate traps around the perimeter of areas. They can intercept migrating flies coming into your area.

5) Use one trap for every 15-20 animals.
