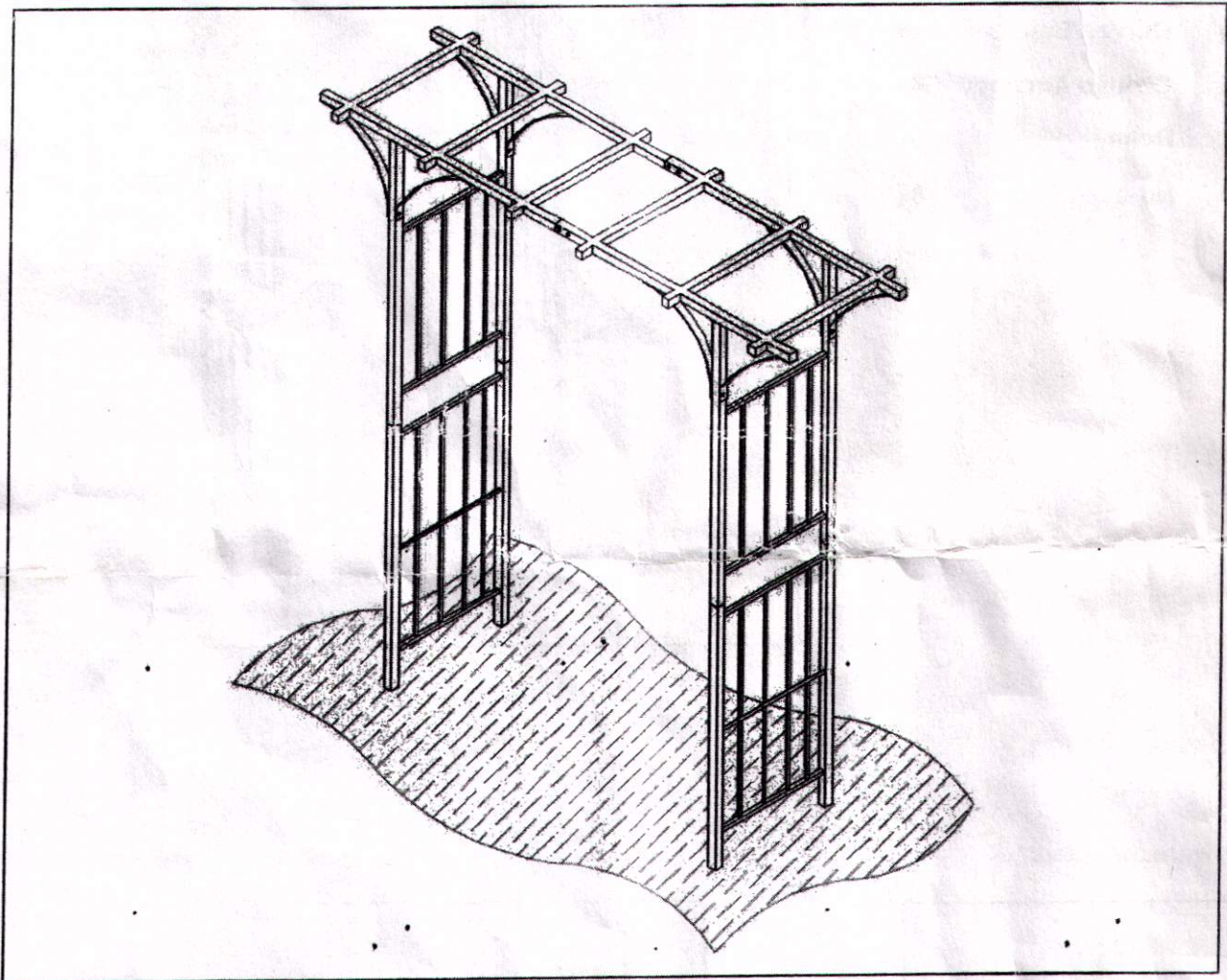




## Assembly Instructions



### Pergola Arch



**Important Safety Instructions:**

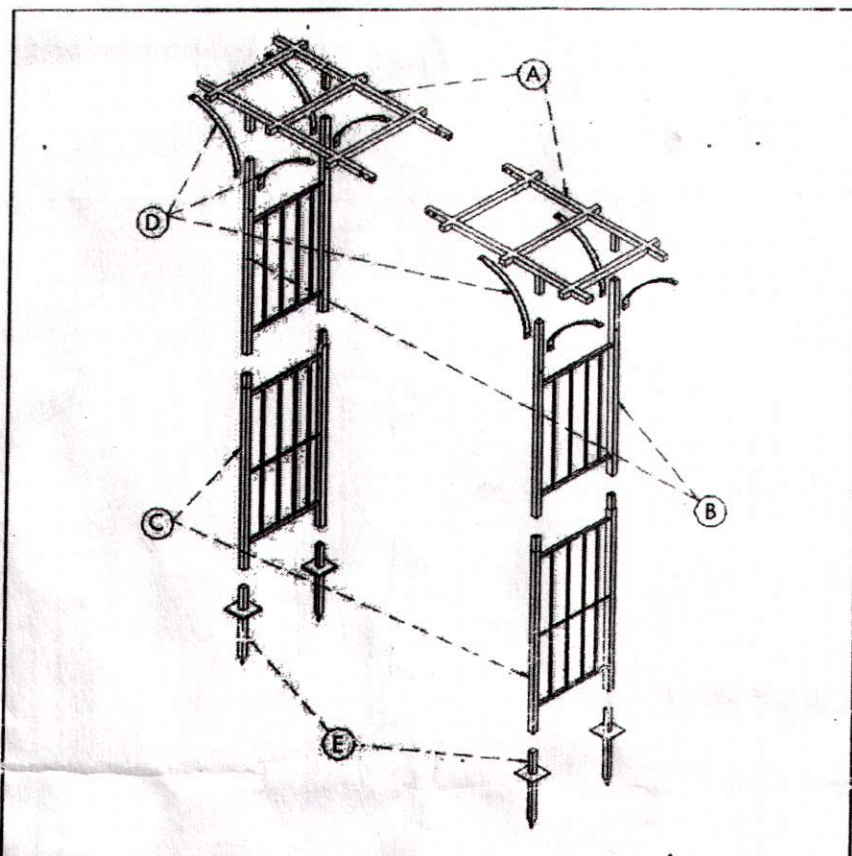
- Do not throw away packaging materials until assembly is complete.
- Assemble the Arch on a flat surface.
- Two people are needed to assemble and move the Pergola Arch.

Nuts and bolts may loosen overtime. Periodically, check that all connections are tight.  
Wipe with a clean, soft, dry cloth.

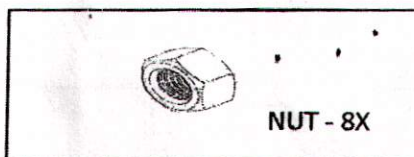
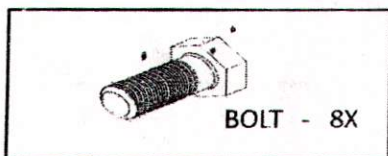

**Parts Included:**

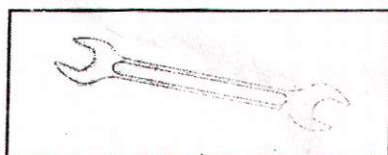

| (A) | Top panels     | 2x |
| (B) | Center Panel   | 2x |
| (C) | Bottom Panel   | 2x |
| (D) | Curved Braces  | 8x |
| (E) | Ground Anchors | 4x |
| (F) | Bolts          | 8x |
| (G) | Nuts           | 8x |

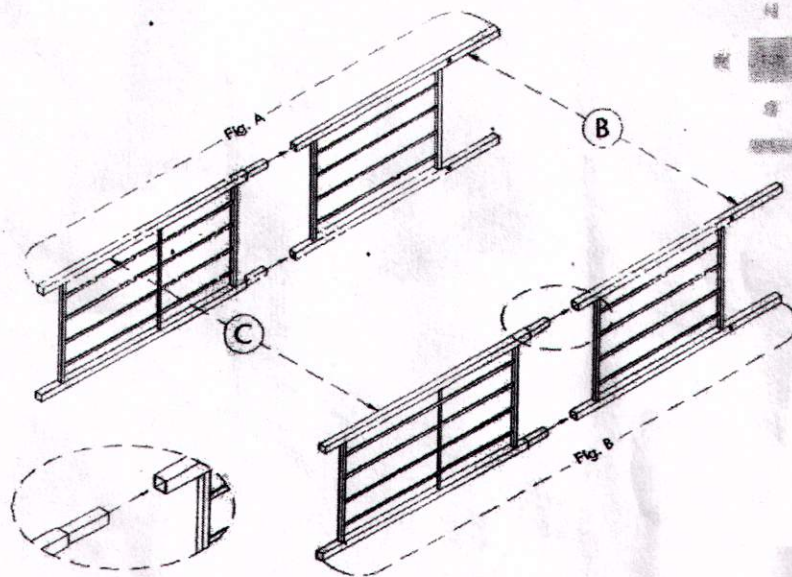
**Required (included) - WRENCH**



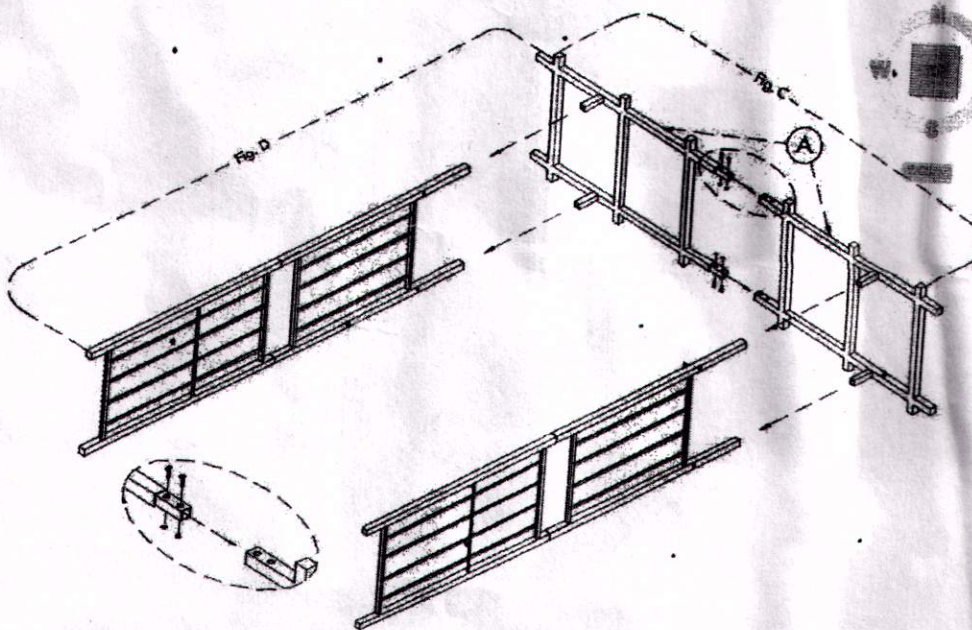


**Assembly Instruction Steps:**

1. Take Bottom Panels – C and Center Panels – B and slide them together by pushing the female ends onto male ends as shown.

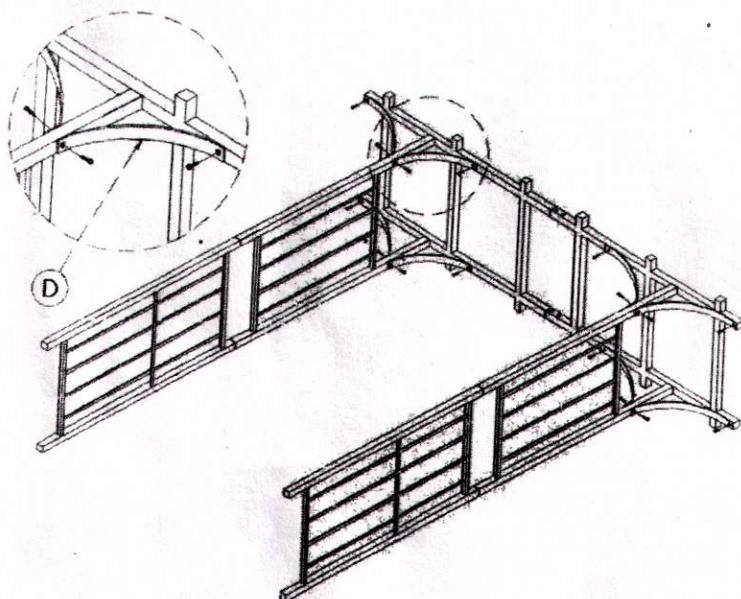


2. Now, join the two Top Panels – A, push the female ends onto male ends as shown. When these are snug, insert bolts, add nuts and tighten with wrench.
3. Push top assembly onto side panel assemblies.

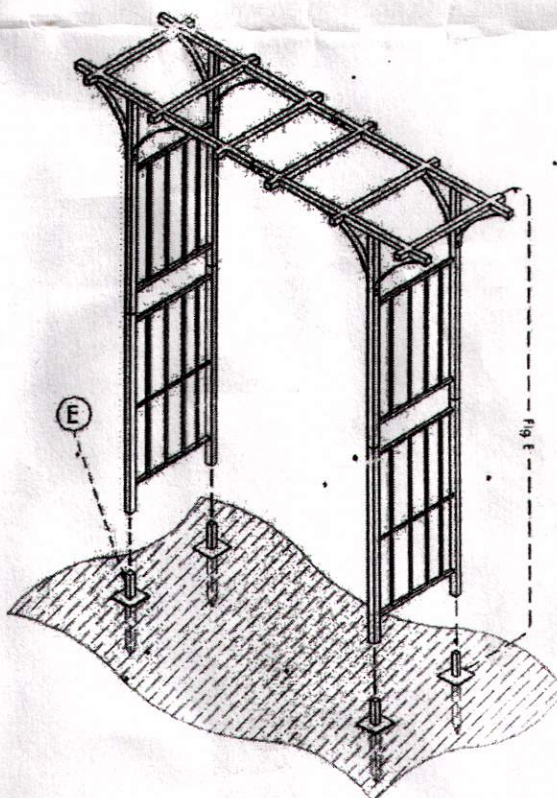




4. Now, attach the 8 curved braces onto the assembled top, using bolts and nuts, as shown below.



5. Place the fully assembled Pergola in upright position, adding Ground Anchors. Push down into ground.



Pergola is ready for use.
