Purple Rain Tea 11003 \$14.50

100% natural loose-leaf purple tea (with twice the antioxidants of green tea and half the caffeine) is grown pesticide-free and hand-picked in Kenya. This tropical Purple Rain blend is an infusion of passionfruit, lemongrass, apple, and a hint of hibiscus. Each tin makes 40 cups and comes with hand-carved teaspoon.



A SERRV partner since 2018, tea farmers in Kenya earn fair prices for their crops and enough income to move into homes with running water. These rural farmers also receive training on sustainable small-scale tea farming and educational opportunities, including a lending library for nearly 800 rural children.

Imbabura Scarf 18206 \$20

Shimmery, colorful, and lightweight, this handmade scarf with gold metallic thread accents and fringe ends is perfect for any time of year! Fabric is a cotton/acrylic blend.



A SERRV partner since 2003, this artisan group in Ecuador, two-thirds of whom are women, receives fair wages as well as access to global markets, product design assistance, and production training. They also utilize traditional weaving materials and techniques in many of their handcrafts, helping to keep indigenous Ecuadorian crafting traditions alive.

Small Grasslands Basket 25099 \$38

Each basket is crafted with hand-dyed sustainable elephant grass woven by hand into bold patterns, then finished with a natural leather-wrapped handle.



A SERRV partner since 2006, this group of basket weavers in northern Ghana earn a fair income during the rainy season, when it's nearly impossible to make a living through farming. They also gain access to business training and health education, and their crafting centers serve as classrooms for local communities without schools.

Kantha Dish Towels, Set of 3 34902 \$32

These dish towels are a special SERRV favorite! Soft, absorbent, and one-of-a-kind, each dish towel is crafted with recycled sari and embellished with hand-stitched kantha embroidery.



A SERRV partner since 1990, this large artisan group in East India receives vital income and safe employment through handcrafting. Women are also empowered to form businesses and become financially independent while working reasonable hours and staying with their families.

West Bank Dipping Bowls 43135 \$34

These beautiful ceramic dipping bowls are hand painted with traditional floral motifs by artisans in West Bank. They're perfect for dips, oils & other small snacks. They're even microwave safe!



A SERRV partner since 2014, this ceramics artisan group in West Bank works to preserve Palestinian culture and access local and global markets. Though they've suffered declining tourism as well as violence in the Middle East, they persevere, continuing to earn a vital income while advocating for peace between Israelis and Palestinians.

Sweet Sacred Mark Soaps, Set of 2 46177 \$16

Each bar of this 100% natural soap is hand-wrapped in colorful paper with a wax thumbprint stamp and then packaged in a recycled sari drawstring bag. The set includes lemongrass honey and lavender coconut scents.



A SERRV partner since 2008, this artisan group in Bangladesh employs women who escaped sex work and human trafficking on the streets of Dhaka. A protective workplace, psychological support, fair wages, and steady handcrafting income help them start a new life.

Mandala Warming Trivet 46330 \$20

This handcrafted terracotta trivet features a whitewashed mandala design, and is perfect for keeping dishes warm while protecting your table! Comes in a handwoven kaisa grass basket.



A SERRV partner since 1976, this artisan group in Bangladesh crafts their warming stones from natural clay gathered from local riverbeds, and hand weaves the baskets from jute grown by local farmers. Over 80% of these artisans are rural women, and each earns much-needed income to pay for household expenses while ensuring their children go to school.

Rainbow Felted Dryer Balls 65811 \$11 each

These bright and colorful 100% wool felt dryer balls are hand felted with no added chemicals. Toss these in to cut static and dry your laundry faster. No two are alike!



A SERRV partner since 1993, the felt-making artisans in this group—90% of whom are women—receive not only support to send their daughters to school in an area where this is rare, but also access to paid maternity leave, which is also rare. For many, felting remains their only source of income while much of Nepal faces lockdowns due to COVID-19.

Bamboo Reusable Utensils 92940 \$22

This handmade travel utensil set is carved from fast-growing and sustainable bamboo packaged in a drawstring muslin carrying sack. The set includes a fork, knife, spoon, straw, and straw cleaner.



A SERRV partner since 1999, this artisan group in Vietnam employs ethnic minorities, women and men with physical disabilities, and victims of the dangerous Agent Orange herbicide used during the Vietnam War. In each of their 70 producer groups across the country, artisans gain access to sustainable and fair employment free of exploitation, and essential healthcare. They also preserve precious traditional craft techniques.

Sisterhood Solidarity Coffee 95738 \$11.95

This delicious, medium-bodied and subtly complex medium organic roast coffee is grown by Las Diosas, a 250-member all-woman cooperative in Nicaragua.



A SERRV partner since 2004, this Wisconsin-based coffee roaster uses eco-friendly methods to roast their coffee beans. They pay fair prices to farmers and through the sales of their beans, these global farmers gain access to revolving credit funds they use to grow household vegetable gardens and raise chickens and pigs for food and sale.
