

Use the wider jaws when sharpening plane iron. Position accordingly: 25° angle — project 2" from edge of jaws 30° angle — project $1\frac{1}{2}$ " from edge of jaws

Use the narrower jaws when sharpening wood chisels. Position accordingly: 25° angle — project 1% from edge of jaws 30° angle — project 1% from edge of jaws

Step 3.

Sharpen knife with even pressure on the push stroke, lift to return and push again. Repeat until sharp. (work sharpening stone evenly for optimum use)

Note: Use liberal amounts of oil.
