

OVAL TEMPLATE INSTRUCTIONS

MAKING PERFECT OVAL PICTURE FRAMES AND PLAQUES HAS NEVER BEEN EASIER.

ATTACHING: Templates are machined from rigid plastic. Attach to material you wish to cut with either double-faced tape or use small nails in the pre-drilled holes. For best results, use in router table with a flush trim or pattern bit.



SELECTING SIZE: The 6-piece set includes templates with 3½" x 5", 5" x 7", 7" x 9", and 9" x 11" inside measurements for picture frames and plaques, and 2" x 3" and 3½" x 5" outside measurements for small plaques. **NOTE:** By changing the bearing size of your router bit or using a template guide you can enlarge or widen your working piece.

CUTTING:

Using a bandsaw, jigsaw or scroll saw rough cut your oval to within a $1/2^{"}$ of the template.

When routing the outside of the work, move the template (or router) in a counter-clockwise motion around the bit. When routing the inside of the work, move the template (or router) in a clockwise motion around the bit.

Start your cut going with the grain of wood. A starter pin is recommended to help control your outside cut.
