



WASHING INSTRUCTIONS – Retain for Future Use

- There is no need to pre-wash any of our products before use.
- Microfiber products (Premium Microfiber and Barrier II) need be washed only when soiled.
- Routine washing of encasings is unnecessary and allows allergen exposure each time the encasing is removed. A slightly damp cloth may be used to remove any surface dust.
- Non-microfiber products should be washed weekly in warm water to remove allergen.

ALL PRODUCTS:

- **no chlorine bleach**
- **no fabric softeners**
- **do not dry clean**
- **do not iron**
